IN RE: SB1488 by Ogden (Relating to the misconduct of a person who is employed by or is seeking employment by a school district, open-enrollment charter school, regional education service center, or shared services arrangement.), **As Engrossed**

The bill amends the Education Code and the Family Code as they relate to reports of child abuse by school personnel.
