**IN RE: SJR3** by West (Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the governor to grant pardons to persons who have received deferred adjudication.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

**The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$85,275.**

The resolution would amend the Texas Constitution by authorizing the governor to grant pardons to persons who have received deferred adjudication. The proposed constitutional amendment would be included on the ballot of the November 4, 2003 general election.
