8	(a) A student in kindergarten or grades one through six may not be
9	assigned for two consecutive school years to a teacher who:
10	(1) has less than one year of teaching experience; or
11	(2) does not hold the appropriate certificate issued
12	by the State Board for Educator Certification.
13	(b) In a subject for which a student is administered ar
14	assessment instrument under Section 39.023(a) or (c), a student in
15	grade seven or higher may not be assigned for two consecutive school
16	years to a teacher who:

- (1) has less than one year of teaching experience; or
- 18 (2) does not hold the appropriate certificate issued
- by the State Board for Educator Certification.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
