A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the appropriation to the Department of State Health
- 3 Services for trauma facility and emergency medical services
- 4 activities.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Rider 84 following the appropriation to the
- 7 Department of State Health Services in Article II, S.B. No. 1, Acts
- 8 of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005 (page II-65 of the
- 9 General Appropriations Act), is amended to read as follows:
- 10 84. Estimated Appropriation: Designated Trauma Facility and
- 11 EMS Account. The Department of State Health Services is hereby
- 12 appropriated any additional revenues generated in General
- 13 Revenue-Dedicated Account 5111, Designated Trauma Facility and
- 14 EMS, above $\frac{$31,792,507}{}$ [\$59,419,000] in fiscal year 2006 and
- 15 \$31,792,507 [\$80,368,000] in fiscal year 2007, for the purpose of
- 16 trauma facility and EMS activities. [The dollar amounts above are
- 17 contained in the Comptroller of Public Accounts' Biennial Revenue
- 18 Estimate, 2006-07 for this account. This appropriation is
- 19 contingent upon the department notifying and receiving approval
- 20 from the Legislative Budget Board and the Governor of its intent to
- 21 access additional revenues from this account. Such an
- 22 appropriation shall be considered to be approved if neither the
- 23 Legislative Budget Board nor the Governor issues a written
- 24 disapproval not later than:

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- 1 [a. the 10th business day after the date the staff of the
- 2 Legislative Budget Board concludes its review of the proposed
- 3 appropriation and forwards its review to the Chair of the House
- 4 Appropriations Committee, Chair of the Senate Finance Committee,
- 5 Speaker of the House, and Lieutenant Governor; and
- 6 [b. the 10th business day after the receipt of the proposed
- 7 appropriation by the Governor.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 13 legislative session.
