- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 467.027(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A commission member is [not] entitled to compensation \underline{in}
- 8 <u>an amount not to exceed \$150,000 per year</u> for serving on the
- 9 commission.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 467.101, Government Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 12 <u>(d) Each commission member is considered a full-time</u>
- 13 employee of this state and shall devote the member's full time to
- 14 the commission's duties.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) In addition to other amounts appropriated to
- 16 the Texas Lottery Commission, \$450,000, plus an additional amount
- 17 necessary to fund benefits associated with state employment, is
- 18 appropriated out of the state lottery account to the Texas Lottery
- 19 Commission for the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2005,
- 20 to pay annual compensation in the amount of \$150,000 to each
- 21 commission member.
- (b) In addition to other amounts appropriated to the Texas
- 23 Lottery Commission, \$450,000, plus an additional amount necessary
- 24 to fund benefits associated with state employment, is appropriated

- out of the state lottery account to the Texas Lottery Commission for
- 2 the state fiscal year beginning September 1, 2006, to pay annual
- 3 compensation in the amount of \$150,000 to each commission member.
- 4 (c) Funds appropriated to the Texas Lottery Commission
- 5 under this section may not be used to pay a commission member
- 6 compensation in a monthly amount that exceeds one-twelfth of the
- 7 amount of annual compensation provided by Section 467.027,
- 8 Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 14 legislative session.
