4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle E, Title 10, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 2206 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 2206. LIMITATION ON USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN FOR ECONOMIC
8	DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES
9	Sec. 2206.001. LIMITATION ON EMINENT DOMAIN FOR ECONOMIC
10	DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES. (a) This section applies to the use of
11	eminent domain under the laws of this state by any governmental or
12	private entity, including:
13	(1) a state agency, including an institution of higher
14	education as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code;
15	(2) a political subdivision of this state; or
16	(3) a corporation created by a governmental entity to
17	act on behalf of the entity.
18	(b) A governmental or private entity may not take private
19	property through the use of eminent domain if the taking is for
20	economic development purposes.
21	(c) This section does not affect the authority of an entity
22	authorized by law to take private property through the use of
23	eminent domain for utility services.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect November 1, 2005.
