6 Mustangs baseball and football teams; during his senior year, this
7 talented athlete caught a memorable touchdown pass and was named
8 second team All District; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Byers also excelled in academics and was known
10 to be a model student and school leader; he attended the First
11 Baptist Church of Paris and had just begun a promising career with
12 Coca-Cola Bottling at the time of his death; and

13 WHEREAS, Although it is painful to say good-bye to one so
14 young and full of promise, it is fitting to remember that while his
15 time on this earth was far too brief, Kris Byers profoundly affected
16 the lives of those around him, and his memory will long endure in
17 the hearts of the countless individuals whose lives he touched;
