1 WHEREAS, Coach Ellis Davis, Jr., and Betty Joe Davis of
2 Dallas have been selected as the recipients of a 2005 Outstanding
3 Texan Award in the area of education by the Texas Legislative Black
4 Caucus; and

5 WHEREAS, Outstanding Texans are honored for the positive
6 impact they have made in their communities, and this couple's
7 myriad contributions as educators have truly enhanced the lives of
8 many individuals in the Dallas area; and

9 WHEREAS, For three decades, Coach Davis served the Dallas
10 Independent School District as a physical education teacher and
11 coach at the elementary, middle, and high school levels; he earned
12 his bachelor's degree in physical education from Bishop College and
13 his master's degree in education from the University of North
14 Texas; and

15 WHEREAS, This noteworthy Texan spent more than 20 years as an
16 athletic coach at Roosevelt High School, where he earned an
17 outstanding 641 wins and consistently led his basketball teams to
18 the top 10; he is the recipient of numerous awards, including
19 induction into the Texas Black Sports Hall of Fame and the Texas
20 African American Coaches Association Hall of Honor; and

21 WHEREAS, Like her husband, Betty Joe Davis is committed to
22 nurturing the lives of young people, and she enjoyed a successful
23 tenure as a teacher with DISD; a graduate of Booker T. Washington
24 High School, she earned her bachelor's degree from Prairie View A&M

1 University and her master's degree in education from North Texas
2 State University; and

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Davis is an active member of her community and
4 has volunteered for a host of civic organizations, including the
5 American Cancer Society, the YWCA, the C. A. W. Legal Clinic, and
6 the African American Museum; she is a lifetime member of the
7 National and State Parent Teacher Associations and has received
8 countless honors for her service and excellence in teaching; a
9 woman of deep faith, she has dedicated herself to many activities at
10 Good Street Baptist Church, where she has volunteered for
11 missionary service and taught Sunday school; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Davis are devoted parents and
13 grandparents, and they have earned the respect and admiration of
14 family, friends, and colleagues through their exceptional and
15 inspirational service to their community; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
17 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby honor Coach Ellis Davis,
18 Jr., and Betty Joe Davis for being named the recipients of a 2005
19 Outstanding Texan Award by the Texas Legislative Black Caucus in
20 the area of education and extend to them sincere best wishes for
21 continued success and happiness; and, be it further
