1 WHEREAS, U.S. Marine Lance Corporal Steven Kelly Schulz of
2 Karnes County has returned home from Iraq after risking his life in
3 service to his country and sustaining serious injuries in combat;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, While working as a gun turret operator, Lance
6 Corporal Schulz was hit by a roadside bomb on April 19, 2005, and
7 narrowly escaped with his life, and his heroism on that day earned
8 him a Purple Heart; and

9 WHEREAS, This courageous young Texan is the son of Steve and
10 Debbie Schulz, who currently reside in Friendswood; his decision to
11 join the Marines in 2001 was largely influenced by his desire to
12 make a positive difference in the world following the attacks of
13 September 11; and

14 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to Lance Corporal
15 Schulz and to all of the country's military personnel, for they are
16 called on to bear great, often unimaginable, burdens, and they
17 render service and sacrifice that is truly beyond measure; and

18 WHEREAS, Through his unfaltering devotion to duty, honor, and
19 this country, Steven Schulz has embodied the highest ideals of the
20 armed forces and earned the lasting respect and gratitude of all
21 Americans; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
23 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby honor U.S. Marine Lance
24 Corporal Steven Kelly Schulz for his brave and steadfast service in
