6 to the early 1890s, when Father Charles Kacer traveled from

7 Frenstat to conduct a monthly mass in Caldwell; the first recorded

8 service was held in August 1893, with the Reverend Jacob Lauth

presiding, and the congregation's first permanent structure, a

small frame building, was erected in 1895 and dedicated to the

11 Blessed Virgin Mary of Lourdes; and

12 WHEREAS, The Galveston hurricane of 1900 destroyed the church

and all its contents, with the exception of a painting of Our Lady

of Lourdes; the church was rebuilt in 1901, and it served its

parishioners well for more than 80 years; in 1984 a new facility was

16 constructed and a bell tower was added in 1997; the painting of Our

17 Lady of Lourdes has been restored and it remains on view in the

18 church; and

19 WHEREAS, Today, members benefit from the leadership of Father

Dimitrij Colankin, who has ably served the church for the past

decade, following in the tradition of the other dedicated religious

leaders whose vision and spiritual guidance have enhanced the lives

of countless area Catholics over the past century; and
