5 WHEREAS, Mr. Torres first hosted *The Spanish Hour* on July 11, 6 1955, at the age of 19; in the 50 years since that noteworthy day, he 7 has established himself as a fixture at the station, introducing 8 new music to his loyal following, while also mentoring and training 9 many of the station's personnel, including current owner and 10 general manager Ray Hendryx; and

11 WHEREAS, Although Mr. Torres has not been the exclusive host 12 of his signature program during its long and successful run, he is 13 credited with setting the standard for this unique and popular 14 show; his skills as a multilingual broadcaster are evidenced by his 15 ability to translate an English script into Spanish on the air, 16 without the benefit of rehearsal, and his knowledge of regional 17 music is unparalleled; and

18 WHEREAS, Vic Torres is an important part of the history of 19 Alpine, and his musical tastes have had a profound effect on 20 generations of listeners; his passion for music, as well as the 21 influence of his dedicated fan base, have kept him behind the 22 microphone for five decades, and people throughout the Alpine area 23 have greatly benefited from his notable contributions; now, 24 therefore, be it
