- 7 which she has served as middle school director and coordinator of
- 8 its annual contest; she is also the founder of the William C. McAfee
- 9 Mathematics Excellence Foundation at Texas A&M University-Commerce
- 10 and a summer math camp for girls at Southern Methodist University;

- 13 numerous accolades, including the Edyth May Sliffe Award for
- 14 distinguished teaching in junior high school mathematics, the
- 15 Honorary Life Membership Award from the Texas Congress of Parents

- 18 committee, she is also the recipient of an innovative teaching
