A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the issuance of revenue bonds for Texas A&M 3 University--Corpus Christi. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 55.1751 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 55.1751. TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL 7 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this 8 9 subchapter, the board of regents of The Texas A&M University System may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or 10 equip facilities, including roads and related infrastructure, for a 11 12 kinesiology and wellness center, a college of business academic facility, and distribution of utilities for Texas A&M 13 14 University--Corpus Christi, to be financed by the issuance of bonds in accordance with this subchapter, including bonds issued in 15 accordance with a systemwide revenue financing program and secured 16 as provided by that program, in an aggregate principal amount not to 17 18 exceed \$58 million. (b) The board of regents may pledge irrevocably to the 19 payment of the bonds authorized by this section all or any part of 20 21 the revenue funds of an institution, branch, or entity of The Texas A&M University System, including student tuition charges. The 22 23 amount of a pledge made under this subsection may not be reduced or abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds 24

1 issued to refund those bonds, are outstanding.

2 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board of 3 regents to meet its obligations under this section, the board may 4 transfer funds among institutions, branches, and entities of The 5 Texas A&M University System to ensure the most equitable and 6 efficient allocation of available resources for each institution, 7 branch, or entity to carry out its duties and purposes.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 13 legislative session.
