S.B. No. 63

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds for The  
3 University of Texas at Austin.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is  
6 amended by adding Section 55.1752 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 55.1752. THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS SYSTEM; ADDITIONAL  
8 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this  
9 subchapter, the board of regents of The University of Texas System  
10 may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, enlarge, or  
11 equip property, buildings, structures, or other facilities,  
12 including roads and related infrastructure, for The University of  
13 Texas at Austin to be used for campus fire and life safety upgrades  
14 and for the Experimental Science Building and to be financed by the  
15 issuance of bonds in accordance with this subchapter, including  
16 bonds issued in accordance with a systemwide revenue financing  
17 program and secured as provided by that program, in an aggregate  
18 principal amount not to exceed \$75 million.

19 (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of  
20 bonds authorized by Subsection (a) all or any part of the revenue  
21 funds of an institution, branch, or entity of The University of  
22 Texas System, including student tuition charges. The amount of a  
23 pledge made under this subsection may not be reduced or abrogated  
24 while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds issued to

1 refund those bonds, are outstanding.

2 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board to  
3 meet its obligations under this section, the board may transfer  
4 funds among institutions, branches, and entities of The University  
5 of Texas System to ensure the most equitable and efficient  
6 allocation of available resources for each institution, branch, or  
7 entity to carry out its constitutional and statutory duties and  
8 purposes.

9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
13 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the  
14 legislative session.
