## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT
relating to the jurisdiction of certain home-rule municipalities on
a barrier island in the Gulf of Mexico.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 43, Local Government Code,
is amended by adding Section 43.904 to read as follows:
Sec. 43.904. JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN HOME-RULE
MUNICIPALITIES OVER BARRIER ISLANDS. (a) In this section,
"barrier island" means an island bordering on the Gulf of Mexico.
(b) This section applies only to a home-rule municipality
that has a population of less than 50,000 and is not predominantly
located on a barrier island.
(c) The home-rule municipality may not:
(1) extend its corporate limits to or have its
extraterritorial jurisdiction on a barrier island on which a
municipality incorporated before November 1, 2005, exists; or
(2) annex land on the island.
(d) An agreement by which a home-rule municipality pledges,
directly or indirectly, taxes or other revenue from or attributable
to territory located on a barrier island does not create an
enforceable right to prevent the reformation of the municipality's
boundary under Subsection (e).
(e) The boundary of a home-rule municipality is void to the

extent that it violates Subsection (c), and the boundary is
