WHEREAS, In 1979, Bruce began his high school coaching career at King High School, where he served as head baseball coach; during a 24-year career, he coached at various schools before returning to Corpus Christi to coach at Ray and Carroll High Schools; he coached football, baseball, and wrestling, and many of his baseball players received college scholarships; and

WHEREAS, This outstanding coach earned the respect of his colleagues and that of his students, who remember his dedication to his work and the sense of fair play, teamwork, and discipline he instilled in them; he retired from his position as a coach in May of this year; and
