## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the standard service retirement annuity for service as
- 3 a member of the legislature.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 814.103, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 814.103. SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR ELECTED CLASS
- 8 SERVICE. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section
- 9 [Subsection (b)], the standard service retirement annuity for
- 10 service credited in the elected class of membership is an amount
- 11 equal to the number of years of service credit in that class, times
- 12 two percent of the state salary, as adjusted from time to time,
- 13 being paid a district judge.
- 14 (b) The standard service retirement annuity for service
- 15 credited in the elected class computed under Subsection (a) may not
- 16 exceed at any time 100 percent of the state salary being paid a
- 17 district judge.
- 18 (c) The standard service retirement annuity for service
- 19 credited in the elected class by a person for service as a member of
- 20 the legislature is an amount equal to the number of years of service
- 21 <u>credit in that class times two percent of the statewide average</u>
- 22 salary being paid a teacher in a public school.
- 23 (d) The standard service retirement annuity for service
- 24 credited in the elected class computed under Subsection (c) may not

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- 1 exceed at any time 100 percent of the statewide average salary being
- 2 paid a teacher in a public school.
- 3 (e) The board of trustees shall annually determine the
- 4 statewide average salary being paid a teacher in a public school for
- 5 purposes of Subsections (c) and (d). The Teacher Retirement System
- 6 of Texas and the Texas Education Agency shall provide, at the
- 7 request of the board of trustees, any information or assistance the
- 8 board of trustees requires to make the determination required by
- 9 this subsection.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 15 legislative session.
