## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

A	N ACT

- 2 relating to the exercise of the power of eminent domain.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. (a) Before September 1, 2007:
- 5 (1) a political subdivision of this state or any other
- 6 entity may not take private property by eminent domain for economic
- 7 development in furtherance of:
- 8 (A) any economic or industrial development plan
- 9 under the Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6,
- 10 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes); or
- 11 (B) a community development or urban renewal plan
- under Chapter 373 or 374, Local Government Code; and
- 13 (2) the Tarrant Regional Water District, operating
- 14 under Chapter 268, Acts of the 55th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 15 1957, may not take private property by eminent domain.
- 16 (b) This section applies to a taking of private property by
- 17 eminent domain pending on the effective date of this Act. For
- 18 purposes of this section, a taking is pending if a condemnation
- 19 petition is filed under Section 21.012, Property Code, and a
- 20 judgment awarding possession of the property to the condemning
- 21 entity has not become final.
- (c) This section expires January 1, 2008.
- 23 SECTION 2. (a) An interim committee is created to study the
- 24 use of the power of eminent domain.

- 1 (b) The interim committee consists of:
- 2 (1) five members of the senate appointed by the
- 3 lieutenant governor; and
- 4 (2) five members of the house of representatives
- 5 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.
- 6 (c) The speaker of the house of representatives shall
- 7 designate one member of the house of representatives appointed to
- 8 the committee to act as co-chair. The lieutenant governor shall
- 9 designate one senator appointed to the committee to act as
- 10 co-chair.
- 11 (d) The interim committee shall:
- 12 (1) study the use of the power of eminent domain,
- 13 including:
- 14 (A) the use of the power of eminent domain for
- 15 economic development purposes; and
- 16 (B) the components of compensation awarded to
- 17 owners of property taken through the power of eminent domain,
- 18 including whether the replacement value of the property or other
- 19 components should be taken into consideration to fully compensate
- 20 property owners; and
- 21 (2) prepare a report of the committee's study for the
- 22 80th Legislature.
- (e) The report required by Subsection (e)(2) of this section
- 24 must be filed with the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the
- 25 house of representatives not later than November 1, 2006.
- 26 (f) This section expires January 1, 2007.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 5 legislative session.
