WHEREAS, Mr. Hollowell served his nation with distinction for nearly four decades as a member of the Air and Army National Guard, earning 18 major service awards and achieving the rank of brevet

lieutenant general by the end of his storied military career; and WHEREAS, This esteemed gentleman was first elected to represent the constituents of Van Zandt, Upshur, and Smith Counties in 1956; during his notable tenure in office, he shared his leadership and expertise as a longtime member of the appropriations committee, as vice chair of the house administration committee, as chair of the state affairs, general investigating, ethics, and public lands and buildings committees, as a member of the Legislative Budget Board, and more; and

WHEREAS, All told, Mr. Hollowell worked to benefit his fellow Texans in the house of representatives for 28 years, making him at the time of his retirement one of only three house members in the
