10 retirement and was serving as Blooming Grove's mayor at the time of
11 his passing; and

14 Society, and an active congregant of Blooming Grove United
15 Methodist Church; and

16 WHEREAS, Our sadness at Gene Hollingsworth's death is eased
17 by the knowledge that his was truly a life well lived and that his
18 unique spirit shines on in the memories of all those fortunate
19 enough to have known him; now, therefore, be it
