R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Memories of a life characterized by a devotion to
2 family and meaningful service to the community may comfort the
3 family and friends of the Honorable Jack Milam, justice of the peace
4 in Victoria County, who passed away on August 7, 2005, at the age of
5 69; and

6 WHEREAS, Born on February 4, 1936, in Clinton, Oklahoma, Mr.
7 Milam graduated from Patti Welder High School in 1954 and received
8 his degree from The University of Texas at Austin in 1962; he was an
9 insurance agent with Farmers Insurance and an apartment-complex
10 owner; and

11 WHEREAS, This U.S. Army veteran had an outstanding record of
12 public service that included serving as vice president of the
13 Victoria ISD's board of directors; he was also a member of the board
14 of the Texas Zoo, the Friends of the Public Library, and the board
15 of the Victoria Bach Festival; furthermore, he was a valued
16 congregant at Christ the Victor Lutheran Church, where he was a lay
17 minister; and

18 WHEREAS, Elected justice of the peace for Precinct 2 in
19 northwestern Victoria County in the early 1990s, he earned a
20 reputation for professionalism and fairness and was widely
21 recognized for his commitment to his community; and

22 WHEREAS, Jack Milam was a devoted family man who loved to
23 travel and was always ready with a joke, and his memory will be
24 forever cherished by those who were blessed to share in his love and

1 friendship; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
3 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of
4 the Honorable Jack Milam and extend sincere sympathy to the members
