R E S O L U T I O N

12 member of the Irving City Council, on which she served from 1978 to  
13 1985; she has also lent her time and talents to the Central

16 chair of the Northeast Texas Systems Advisory Council and the  
17 Irving Transportation Task Force; and

18           WHEREAS, A graduate of Southern Methodist University, this  
19 esteemed professional works as an independent appraiser and has  
20 earned her real estate broker's license and appraisal designation  
21 from Dallas College; and

22           WHEREAS, Through her untiring dedication and able  
23 leadership, Norma Stanton has contributed in meaningful and lasting  
24 ways to the quality of life in Dallas County, and it is indeed a
