- 1 WHEREAS, The East Texas Choctaw Tribe of more than 200
- 2 families exists in Newton and Jasper Counties as a distinct
- 3 community sharing customs and traditions, kinship organization,
- 4 and religious beliefs and practices; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Descendents of James Tyler, the East Texas Choctaw
- 6 are also related to Meredith (Maraday) Tyler, who was born at the
- 7 Clifton Choctaw Reservation in Rapids Parish, Louisiana, in 1864
- 8 and died in Bon Wier, Texas, in 1937; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Clifton Choctaw Tribe was formally recognized as
- 10 an Indian tribe by the State of Louisiana more than 50 years ago,
- 11 and East Texas Choctaw Tribe members take justifiable pride in
- 12 being descendents of a historical Indian tribe; and
- WHEREAS, Throughout the years, the East Texas Choctaw have
- 14 played an integral role in Texas' development, and the Native
- 15 American tribes who were among the first Texans have greatly
- 16 enriched our shared heritage with their culture; and
- WHEREAS, Given the tribe's valuable contributions to Texas'
- 18 history and diversity, the Texas House of Representatives finds
- 19 that it is appropriate to encourage the East Texas Choctaw Tribe to
- 20 preserve its cultural and spiritual heritage and traditions; now,
- 21 therefore, be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
- 23 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby honor the East Texas
- 24 Choctaw Tribe and commend the tribe's efforts to preserve its
