currently serves as chairman of the Committee on Administration and the Executive Committee of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (EPC); he has also served as the moderator of the General Assembly of the EPC, leading the entire denomination and providing invaluable assistance to various presbyteries and pastors; and

WHEREAS, In retirement Dr. Littlejohn looks forward to spending more time with his beloved wife, Jane, and pursuing various outdoor activities, such as hunting and fishing; he is also considering a reintroduction to the game of golf, a pastime he enjoyed during his years as a U.S. Air Force jet pilot, and plans to devote more time to travel, working in behalf of his church, and supporting the Cypress Valley Republicans; and
