

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Sergeant Robert Trevino, Jr., has rendered valiant
2 service in Iraq as a member of the United States Army; and

3 WHEREAS, A 1992 graduate of Weslaco High School, where he was
4 a member of the Rodeo Club, Sergeant Trevino joined the army in 1999
5 and again in 2002; and

6 WHEREAS, Sergeant Trevino has most recently been assigned to
7 the 3rd Battalion, 21st Infantry Regiment, which embarked for Iraq
8 with the 1st Brigade, 25th Infantry Division, in October 2004;
9 deployed for a 12-month tour of duty, Sergeant Trevino and his
10 fellow soldiers have operated in and around the northern city of
11 Mosul; and

12 WHEREAS, On July 25, 2005, his 33rd birthday, Sergeant
13 Trevino suffered serious burns in a car bombing attack; he was
14 subsequently evacuated to a San Antonio burn care unit to recover
15 from his injuries; following his release, he will be returning to
16 Washington; and

17 WHEREAS, This courageous Texan is the husband of Courtney
18 Allison Trevino and the father of Danielle Nichole Trevino; his
19 parents are Rosa Ramirez Trevino and the late Robert Trevino, Sr.;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt to Sergeant Trevino
22 and to all the country's military personnel, for they are called on
23 in wartime to bear unimaginable burdens, and they render service
24 and sacrifice that are truly beyond measure; and

1 WHEREAS, Through his unswerving devotion to duty, honor, and
2 this nation, Sergeant Trevino embodies the highest ideals of the
3 U.S. armed forces, and it is indeed a privilege to recognize him at
4 this time; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
6 Legislature, 2nd Called Session, hereby commend Sergeant Robert
7 Trevino, Jr., for his courageous service in Iraq and extend to him
8 sincere best wishes for his recovery; and, be it further

9 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
10 prepared for Sergeant Trevino as an expression of high regard by the
11 Texas House of Representatives.
