WHEREAS, On July 25, 2005, his 33rd birthday, Sergeant Trevino suffered serious burns in a car bombing attack; he was subsequently evacuated to a San Antonio burn care unit to recover from his injuries; following his release, he will be returning to Washington; and

WHEREAS, This courageous Texan is the husband of Courtney Allison Trevino and the father of Danielle Nichole Trevino; his parents are Rosa Ramirez Trevino and the late Robert Trevino, Sr.; and
