8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Borrego is a devoted woman of faith and a member
9 of San Elizario Church; always eager to attend a "fiesta," she has
10 been an active participant in the senior citizens centers of Fabens
11 and San Elizario; she has also distinguished herself as a committed
12 member of the San Elizario Genealogy and Historical Society at Los
13 Portales; and

14 WHEREAS, An exceptional mother, cook, and seamstress
15 throughout her full and generous life, Cornelia Borrego remains a
16 source of inspiration to her loved ones at 102 years of age, and her
17 generous optimism and kind spirit brighten the lives of all those
