1 WHEREAS, The certain knowledge of a life well lived may
2 temper the profound sadness that the passing of F. M. "Roe" Miller
3 on April 23, 2005, at the age of 86, brings to all who loved this
4 distinguished Texan; and

5 WHEREAS, Born on August 2, 1918, in Fort Davis, Mr. Miller
6 served with distinction in the U.S. Navy for four years during World
7 War II; flying off aircraft carriers *Saratoga* and *Yorktown* in the
8 South Pacific, he belonged to the first squadron to fly naval planes
9 over Tokyo in 1945; and

10 WHEREAS, On March 29, 1945, he married Gene Barton Miller;
11 they enjoyed a special union blessed with a daughter and a son, and
12 they shared in the joy of welcoming into their family four
13 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller was a consummate cowboy and followed his
15 trade from the Mexican border to the Canadian line; he was a member
16 of the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Davis, Huntley Project
17 Masonic Lodge No. 144 in Worden, Montana, and the Scottish Rite of
18 El Paso, as well as a past patron of the Order of the Eastern Star in
19 Fabens; in May 2003, he was inducted into the Big Bend Cowboy Hall
20 of Fame in Marfa; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Miller enjoyed many adventurous trails in his
22 life, and while he will be deeply missed, his spirit will continue
23 to live in the hearts of those individuals who were fortunate enough
24 to have known him; now, therefore, be it
