12 until midnight, in the Valley; and

14 Dr. Barrera is a cofounder of The University of Texas Residency
15 Program in McAllen; and

16 WHEREAS, Dr. Barrera's contributions to the community extend
17 far beyond his professional life; he chairs the board of Rio
18 National Bank and has served as president of the Rio Grande Boy
19 Scout Council, the Hidalgo-Starr Counties Medical Society, and the
20 McAllen Citizens League; and

21 WHEREAS, This talented Texan's dedication to the greater good
22 is indeed deserving of the respect, gratitude, and admiration of
23 his fellow citizens, and we join them in saluting his
24 accomplishments at this time; now, therefore, be it
