2 Doering were greatly saddened by his passing on January 25, 2005,
3 and we join them in mourning their loss; and

4 WHEREAS, A native Chicagoan, Mr. Doering attended
5 Northwestern University, and he served with distinction in the U.S.
6 Navy as a landing craft operator in the Pacific theater of
7 operations during World War II; and

8 WHEREAS, On his return to Chicago, he worked with the
9 Manhattan Project before embarking on his career in the aircraft
10 and aerospace industries; and

11 WHEREAS, In his capacity as a storage and scheduling
12 specialist, Mr. Doering was responsible for many of the complex
13 technical tasks that would later come to be accomplished by
14 computers, and he brought his characteristic intelligence and
15 diligence to this demanding work; and

16 WHEREAS, After his retirement from the aeronautics industry,
17 Mr. Doering and his wife, La Marilys, started their own janitorial
18 business, which they ran together for six years; and

19 WHEREAS, Throughout their marriage, Mr. Doering enjoyed the
20 love and support from his wife, as well as from his two daughters
21 and five grandchildren, and while he is sorely missed by his family,
22 they may take comfort in the knowledge that his unique and
23 irreplaceable spirit will continue to burn on brightly in the
24 hearts of all those who knew him; now, therefore, be it
