4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 43, Local Government Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 43.904 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 43.904. JURISDICTION OF CERTAIN HOME-RULE
8	MUNICIPALITIES OVER BARRIER ISLANDS. (a) In this section,
9	"barrier island" means an island bordering on the Gulf of Mexico.
10	(b) This section applies only to a home-rule municipality
11	that has a population of less than 50,000 and is not predominantly
12	located on a barrier island.
13	(c) The home-rule municipality may not:
14	(1) extend its corporate limits to or have its
15	extraterritorial jurisdiction on a barrier island on which a
16	municipality incorporated before December 1, 2005, exists; or
17	(2) annex land on the island.
18	(d) An agreement by which a home-rule municipality pledges,
19	directly or indirectly, taxes or other revenue from or attributable
20	to territory located on a barrier island does not create an
21	enforceable right to prevent the reformation of the municipality's
22	boundary under Subsection (e).
23	(e) The boundary of a home-rule municipality is void to the
24	extent that it violates Subsection (c), and the boundary is
