A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature 2 to authorize the governing body of a political subdivision to 3 establish for purposes of ad valorem taxation by the political 4 subdivision a lower limit on the maximum average annual percentage 5 increase in the appraised value of residence homesteads in the 6 political subdivision.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

8 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is 9 amended by adding Subsection (i-1) to read as follows:

(i-1) Notwithstanding Subsections (a), (b), and (i) of this 10 11 section, the Legislature by general law may authorize the governing 12 body of a political subdivision to establish for purposes of ad valorem taxation by the political subdivision a limit on the 13 14 maximum average annual percentage increase in the appraised value of residence homesteads in the political subdivision that is less 15 than 10 percent but not less than three percent. A limitation on 16 residence homestead appraisal increases established under this 17 subsection takes effect and expires in the manner provided by 18 Subsection (i) of this section. If the governing body of a 19 political subdivision establishes a limit on appraisal increases 20 21 under this subsection, the limitation remains in effect until amended, repealed, or rescinded by the governing body. An 22 23 amendment, repeal, or rescission of the limit on appraisal 24 increases may not take effect before January 1 of the sixth tax year

following the tax year in which the limitation on appraisal 1 2 increases was established. A subsequent amendment of the limit on appraisal increases may not take effect before January 1 of the 3 4 sixth tax year following the tax year in which the preceding 5 amendment was adopted. 6 SECTION 2.
