5	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
7	adding Section 49-d-10 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 49-d-10. (a) The Texas Water Development Board may
9	issue additional general obligation bonds, at its determination,
10	for the economically distressed areas program account of the Texas
11	Water Development Fund II, in an amount not to exceed \$785 million.
12	The bonds shall be used to provide financial assistance to
13	economically distressed areas of the state as defined by law.
14	(b) Section 49-d-8(e) of this article applies to the bonds
15	authorized by this section.
16	SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
17	submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2005.
18	The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
19	proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
20	issuance of additional general obligation bonds by the Texas Water

Development Board in an amount not to exceed \$785 million to provide

assistance to economically distressed areas."
