WHEREAS, Tom's military career included two tours of duty in Vietnam with the 173rd Airborne Brigade and as an advisor to a Vietnamese army unit; he also served with the 101st Airborne at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and with the Command and General Staff at the Pentagon; he was serving with the Fifth Army at Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio when he retired as a lieutenant colonel in 1985; and

WHEREAS, Over the course of his career, Tom received numerous awards and citations, including the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal, and the Defense Meritorious Service Medal; and

WHEREAS, Following his military career, Tom pursued his passion for mathematics by teaching at Palo Alto College, San Antonio College, the University of the Incarnate Word, and the Texas Military Institute; and

WHEREAS, A man of courage, strength, and compassion, Tom gave generously of himself to others, and his wisdom, warmth, and valued counsel will not be forgotten by those who knew him; and

WHEREAS, A devoted husband, father, and grandfather, Tom leaves behind memories that will be cherished forever by his family and many friends; now, therefore, be it
