A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of 3 public schools. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by 5 6 adding Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) and amending Subsection (d) to read as follows: 7 (c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2006-2007 8 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time 9 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse 10 is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of: 11 12 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have 13 received for the 2006-2007 school year under the district's salary schedule for the 2005-2006 school year, if that schedule had been in 14 effect for the 2006-2007 school year, including any local 15 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement 16 the employee would have received in the 2006-2007 school year; and 17 18 (2) \$300. (c-2) Subsection (c-1) and this subsection expire September 19 1, 2007. 20 21 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse 22 employed by a school district in the 2006-2007 [2000-2001] school 23 year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district, 24

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entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the 1 employee received for the 2006-2007 [2000-2001] school year. 2 3 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is 4 amended by adding Section 42.2516 to read as follows: Sec. 42.2516. ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST 5 6 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A school district, including a school district that is otherwise 7 8 ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the 9 product of \$3,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers, 10 full-time librarians, full-time counselors certified under 11 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by 12 the district and entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402. 13 14 (b) A school district that is required to take action under 15 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which 16 17 the district is entitled under this section, against the total amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase 18 19 attendance credits. (c) A determination by the commissioner under this section 20 21 is final and may not be appealed. (d) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this 22 23 section. 24 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-2007 25 school year. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27
