5 SECTION 1. Section 22.103, Education Code, as added by

7 is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 22.103. DISTRIBUTION BY AGENCY. Each [Subject to the

availability of funds, each] month the agency shall deliver to each

district, including a district that is ineligible for state aid

under Chapter 42, each other educational district that is a member

of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, each participating

charter school, and each regional education service center state

funds in an amount, as determined by the agency, equal to the

15 product of the number of employees employed by the district,

school, or service center multiplied by \$1,000, or a greater [the]

17 amount specified in the General Appropriations Act for purposes of

this subchapter $\underline{\,}$  and divided by 12. The agency shall distribute

19 funding to only one entity for employees who are employed by more

20 than one entity listed in this section.

21 SECTION 2. Sections 22.103-22.110, Education Code, as added

22 by Chapter 899, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular Session,

23 2005, are repealed.
