## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the use of credits for textbooks or other instructional

materials in a school district or open-enrollment charter school.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. It is the intent of the legislature that Section
- 6 31.1011, Education Code, as enacted by this Act, is reflective of
- 7 Section 31.1011, Education Code, as enacted by Section 3, Chapter
- 8 805, Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Education Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 31.1011 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 31.1011. TEXTBOOK CREDITS. (a) A school district or
- 12 open-enrollment charter school is entitled to receive credit for
- 13 textbooks purchased at a cost below the cost limit established
- 14 under Section 31.025(a).

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- 15 (b) The credit is an amount equal to the difference between
- 16 the price paid for a textbook and the cost limit established under
- 17 Section 31.025(a) for that textbook multiplied by the number of
- 18 copies of that textbook the school district or open-enrollment
- 19 charter school purchases.
- 20 (c) Fifty percent of the total textbook credit of a school
- 21 district or open-enrollment charter school shall be credited to the
- 22 state textbook fund, and 50 percent of the credit shall be credited
- 23 to the district or school to apply toward the requisition of
- 24 additional textbooks, electronic textbooks, or technological

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- 1 equipment for use as described by Section 31.002(4)(A).
- 2 (d) The commissioner shall prepare a report relating to the
- 3 use of the textbook credit system and deliver the report to the 81st
- 4 Legislature. This subsection expires June 1, 2009.
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 31.1011, Education Code, as added by
- 6 this Act, applies beginning with the 2006-2007 school year.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 12 legislative session.
