3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 11.201, Education Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
6	(e) A superintendent may not receive any financial benefit
7	for personal services performed by the superintendent for any
8	business entity that conducts or solicits business with the school
9	district. Any financial benefit received by the superintendent for
10	performing personal services for any other entity must be approved
11	by the board of trustees on a case-by-case basis in an open meeting.
12	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
13	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
14	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
15	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
16	Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
17	legislative session.
