A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the examination for licensing as a physician. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 1.51, Chapter 269, Acts of the 79th 4 Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is amended by adding Subsection 5 6 (d-1) to read as follows: (d-1) The change in law made by this article to Section 7 155.056, Occupations Code, applies only to an applicant submitting 8 an application for a license under Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations 9 Code, on or after September 1, 2005, who has not passed each part of 10 the examination required by Section 155.056, Occupations Code, as 11 12 amended by this article. An applicant submitting an application for a license under Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code, on or 13 14 after September 1, 2005, who passed each part of the examination required by Section 155.056, Occupations Code, as that section 15 existed immediately before September 1, 2005, is governed by the 16 law in effect immediately before that date, and the former law is 17 18 continued in effect for that purpose. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 24 legislative session.
