## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) to
7	read as follows:
8	(c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2006-2007
9	school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
LO	counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
L1	is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the sum of:
L2	(1) the monthly salary the employee would have
L3	received for the 2006-2007 school year under the district's salary
L4	schedule for the 2005-2006 school year, if that schedule had been in
L5	effect for the 2006-2007 school year, including any local
L6	supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
L7	the employee would have received in the 2006-2007 school year; and
L8	<u>(2) \$600.</u>
L9	(c-2) Subsection (c-1) and this subsection expire September
20	<u>1, 2007.</u>
21	(d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
22	counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse
23	employed by a school district in the $2006-2007$ [ $2000-2001$ ] school
24	year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,

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- 1 entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the
- 2 employee received for the 2006-2007 [ $\frac{2000-2001}{2000}$ ] school year.
- 3 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 4 amended by adding Section 42.2516 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 42.2516. ADDITIONAL STATE AID OR CREDIT AGAINST COST
- 6 OF ATTENDANCE CREDITS FOR PROFESSIONAL STAFF SALARIES. (a) A
- 7 <u>school district</u>, including a school district that is otherwise
- 8 <u>ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state</u>
- 9 <u>aid in an amount, as determined by the commissioner, equal to the</u>
- 10 product of \$6,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers,
- 11 <u>full-time</u> librarians, full-time counselors certified under
- 12 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by
- the district and entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402.
- (b) A school district that is required to take action under
- 15 Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to which
- 17 the district is entitled under this section, against the total
- amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to purchase
- 19 attendance credits.
- 20 (c) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- 21 <u>is final and may not be appealed.</u>
- 22 (d) The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 23 <u>section</u>.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-2007
- 25 school year.
- 26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 4 legislative session.
