A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for school district

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article VII, Texas Constitution, is amended by 6 adding Section 3A to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 3A. (a) In this section:
- 8 (1) "Available state revenue" means state revenue from
 9 any source other than federal funds. The term does not include
 10 revenue that, under another provision of this constitution, may be
- 11 used only for a particular purpose.
- 12 (2) "Increase in available state revenue" means the
- amount by which the estimate made by the comptroller of public
- 14 accounts under Section 49a(a), Article III, of this constitution of
- 15 available state revenue for the succeeding fiscal biennium exceeds
- 16 the estimate made by the comptroller under that section of
- 17 available state revenue for the current fiscal biennium.
- 18 (b) In each fiscal biennium, an amount of general revenue
- 19 equal to one-third of any increase in available state revenue for
- 20 the biennium must be used to reduce, as provided by general law, the
- 21 rate of the school district maintenance tax authorized by Section
- 22 3(e) of this article.
- 23 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 24 the Texas Constitution:

- TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 79th Legislature,
