2 Police Department on August 31, 2006, concluding an impressive  
3 31-year career in law enforcement; and

4           WHEREAS, Before joining the Euless Police Department six  
5 years ago, Chief Carmack was a member of the Irving Police  
6 Department; the U.S. Air Force veteran signed on with the Irving  
7 department in 1975 and rose through the ranks before retiring as  
8 assistant chief of police after 25 years of service; and

9           WHEREAS, During his outstanding tenure in Euless, Chief  
10 Carmack has endeavored to promote a strong sense of community among  
11 the department's officers, a feeling he sought to re-create from  
12 his early days with the Irving police force; and

13           WHEREAS, Chief Carmack has ably helped to safeguard the lives  
14 and property of his fellow citizens for more than three decades, and  
15 his well-deserved retirement will offer him the opportunity to  
16 travel with his beloved wife, Joyce, and to look back with pride on  
17 all he has achieved over the course of his notable career; now,
