

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Family and friends of the Reverend Amado Hinojosa
2 were deeply saddened by his passing on March 29, 2006, at the age of
3 87, in Dallas; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Mexico, Reverend Hinojosa graduated from the
5 Instituto Biblico Magdiel in 1945 and began his career in the
6 ministry in his native land; he moved his family to Lubbock in 1959
7 and taught himself English by reading newspapers and listening to
8 the radio; and

9 WHEREAS, The family moved to Dallas in 1964, and Reverend
10 Hinojosa accepted the pastorate of El Calvario Asambleas de Dios,
11 where he served for 25 years; he later founded El Buen Pastor
12 Ministries Asambleas de Dios in Oak Cliff; and

13 WHEREAS, Reverend Hinojosa was known on both sides of the
14 border for his preaching, and he held regional administrative posts
15 with the Assemblies of God as a presbyter and secretary-treasurer
16 in Texas and Mexico; in addition, he mentored numerous pastors
17 through an evening Bible school in Dallas where he taught; and

18 WHEREAS, A loving husband and father to his 10 children,
19 Reverend Hinojosa also earned his barber's license to earn extra
20 money; he took great delight in his family, which grew to include 22
21 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren, as well as in the
22 friendships he made while cutting hair; and

23 WHEREAS, The legacy of service and achievement that Reverend
24 Hinojosa leaves exemplifies a life well lived, and the memories of

1 joyful times, loving moments, and meaningful accomplishments may
2 comfort all those who held him dear; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
4 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby pay tribute to the life of
5 the Reverend Amado Hinojosa and extend sincere sympathy to the
6 members of his family: to his wife of 65 years, Guadalupe "Lupita"
7 de los Reyes-Valdez; to his sons, Michael, Amado, Joel, Aaron, and
8 Dan Hinojosa; to his daughters, Martha Hinojosa-Nadler, Ana Maria
9 Estrada, Noemi Hinojosa, Magda Hinojosa Beltran, and Sarah
10 Hinojosa-Glover; to his grandchildren and great-grandchildren; and
11 to his other relatives and many friends; and, be it further
