18 WHEREAS, A loving husband and father to his 10 children, 19 Reverend Hinojosa also earned his barber's license to earn extra 20 money; he took great delight in his family, which grew to include 22 21 grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren, as well as in the 22 friendships he made while cutting hair; and

Hinojosa leaves exemplifies a life well lived, and the memories of
