1 WHEREAS, Justin James Veltman of Boy Scouts of America Troop
2 No. 384 in Burleson has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Veltman earned 22 merit badges and successfully
8 completed an Eagle Scout project of benefit to his community, which
9 involved cleaning and painting a room used for storage at Green Oaks
10 School in Arlington so it could be used as a classroom; and

12 his participation in President George W. Bush's gubernatorial
13 inauguration in January 1999 and presidential inauguration in
14 January 2001, as well as Governor Rick Perry's gubernatorial
15 inauguration in 2003; and

17 leadership ability; in addition to his induction into the Order of
18 the Arrow, he has ably served his fellow scouts as patrol leader,
19 assistant patrol leader, troop librarian, and senior patrol leader,
20 winning their respect and admiration as he worked toward the
21 highest rank that scouting offers; and

22 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Veltman's dedication to excellence and
23 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy
24 to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with

1 pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

3 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby congratulate Justin James
4 Veltman on earning the rank of Eagle Scout, and extend to him
