1 WHEREAS, The football team of Highland Park High School in
2 Dallas won the University Interscholastic League Class 4A Division
3 I State Championship on December 10, 2005, taking home its third
4 state football title in the school's history; and

5 WHEREAS, In their campaign to win the state crown, the
6 Highland Park Scots compiled a perfect 15-0 record, dominating most
7 of their opponents with a mixture of explosive, pass-oriented
8 offense and crushing defense; and

9 WHEREAS, The team won many of its games by large margins,
10 including the 59-0 victory in the championship match-up with the

12 gutsy determination to make key plays when victory hung in the

15 interception set up a Highland Park touchdown in the final minute to
16 give the team a 41-38 win and a trip to the championship game; and
