2 Antonio marked its 55th anniversary on December 11, 2005; and

4 its first service on November 5 of that year, with the Reverend O.
5 W. Hodges presiding; the church building, purchased from Hackberry
6 Street Methodist Church by Bishop Joseph Gomez, was officially
