WHEREAS, Born in Chicago in 1952, Reverend Thurston earned 5 6 his bachelor's degree in religion from Bishop College in Dallas and pursued postgraduate studies at Wheaton College in Illinois; he 7 preached his first sermon on Easter Sunday in 1971, and he was 8 subsequently ordained and appointed as assistant pastor of New 9 Covenant Missionary Baptist Church in Chicago; he eventually 10 followed in his father's and grandfather's footsteps and became the 11 12 third generation of Thurstons to be appointed pastor of this 13 venerable house of worship; a well-known and respected revivalist, 14 Reverend Thurston has ably led his own congregation for more than 25 years, and his ministry has reached communities in Africa, the 15 Caribbean, and the Middle East; and 16

WHEREAS, In September 2003, he was elected as 14th president of the NBCA, a fellowship of churches with a membership of approximately five million African American Baptists; an accomplished author and community leader, he previously served as third vice president of the organization for 15 years, and he holds the distinction of being the youngest president in its history; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Thurston has been named one of America's
