

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Association of Ministers' Wives and
2 Ministers' Widows gathered in the Alamo City for its annual
3 conference on February 17-18, 2006; and

4 WHEREAS, Hosted by the San Antonio membership, participants
5 opened their yearly meeting with a welcome and worship service at
6 Lilly of the Valley Missionary Baptist Church; and

7 WHEREAS, "Keeping the Vision Going: Reaching Out, Reclaiming
8 and Retaining" was chosen as the 2006 theme for the Lone Star State
9 group, which was chartered in June 1988 by the International
10 Association of Ministers' Wives and Ministers' Widows, Inc.; and

11 WHEREAS, Since the creation of the Texas affiliate, chapters
12 have been founded in El Paso, Houston, San Antonio, Austin,
13 Midland-Odessa, Corpus Christi, Waco, and Wichita Falls, and women
14 from Dallas and Edna have also participated in the meetings and work
15 of the association; Austin served as the site of the initial state
16 conference in 1990, and chapters in El Paso and Houston sent the
17 first Texas representatives to attend an international meeting; and

18 WHEREAS, The key words "Love, Faith, and Prayer" are included
19 on the seal of the international association, reminding the
20 interdenominational membership of their high purpose; committed to
21 building a better world, the women of the Texas organization give
22 generously of their time, talents, and resources in support of the
23 Children's Defense Fund, the Sickle Cell Anemia Foundation, the
24 United Negro College Fund, and scholarships for Texas youth; and

1 WHEREAS, Since 1988, wives and widows of Texas ministers have
2 made a positive difference in the quality of life for countless
3 individuals, and it is a distinct pleasure to join in honoring this
4 respected organization; now, therefore, be it

7 associated with the Texas Association of Ministers' Wives and
