RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, On Saturday, January 21, 2006, the community of 2 Three Rivers paid tribute to one of its illustrious citizens by 3 dedicating a park in the name of Aristeo Ponce; and

WHEREAS, This homage to Mr. Ponce is indeed fitting as it provides a permanent monument to this respected leader in the heart of the Barrio neighborhood that he loved so well; it was there that he established a grocery and a dance hall, both of which became important institutions for the Hispanic community of Three Rivers beginning in the mid-1900s; and

WHEREAS, Born in 1896 in Monterrey, Mexico, Mr. Ponce grew up 10 11 in an era when towns were tightly knit and neighbors took care of 12 one another, and he sought to live up to those ideals for the rest of 13 his life; a businessperson who put compassion ahead of profit, his 14 generous credit terms helped families to survive in times of need, while the alcohol-free A. Ponce Dance Hall gave both adults and 15 children a wholesome place to enjoy music and to enjoy themselves; 16 and 17

18 WHEREAS, A proud American who saw seven of his 11 children 19 serve in the United States military, Mr. Ponce also upheld his 20 Mexican heritage and urged his neighbors to do the same; this was 21 especially true during the holidays of Cinco de Mayo and Diez y Seis 22 de Septiembre, when Mr. Ponce sponsored well-loved community 23 celebrations where the history, customs, and language of Mexico 24 were honored and where the flags of the United States, Texas, and

1 Mexico stood side by side; and

WHEREAS, The influence of this civic leader did not end on his passing in 1973 but has continued to be felt in the decades since, inspiring the residents of Three Rivers to reach out to one another in hopes of creating a safe and enjoyable place to live; and

6 WHEREAS, In a time when strong communities and families are 7 more important than ever, the dedication of Aristeo Ponce Park, a 8 place where neighbors can come together, serves as a hopeful sign 9 that the worthy ideals promoted by Mr. Ponce are alive and well in 10 his South Texas hometown; now, therefore, be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas 12 Legislature, 3rd Called Session, hereby honor the memory of Aristeo 13 Ponce and commemorate the dedication of the park named in his honor; 14 and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That official copies of this resolution be prepared 16 for the city and for Mr. Ponce's family as an expression of high 17 regard by the Texas House of Representatives.
